Thank You All

I've heard several people say, very graciously, that I came along at a time that helped the church when it was in great difficulty. While I am grateful for those thoughts, I should share with you that Preston City Congregational Church went a long way toward helping me reclaim my idea of church.

Let me explain. Since leaving St. Andrew Presbyterian Church in July of 2015, I have often had the privilege and pleasure of being "that guest preacher" at various churches. Unfortunately, most of the time, the churches were struggling. Two of the seven had no children, and the other five didn't have two dozen young people between them.

Then the pandemic came, and the situation became worse. Interestingly, after "Zoom worship only" ended and pandemic restrictions were relaxed, the churches I helped became older! It was the younger people who didn't return, and the number of kids who had been in worship fell to almost zero.

Only PCCC continued to have diversity in who attended worship. It felt the way a church is supposed to feel. That observation, and a push from my wife, led me to cobble together with Stan a plan to help the church beginning in March of 2023.

Oh, I've had so much fun! The idea that church could be joyful again gave, and gives, me hope. I owe you a debt of gratitude. I will miss tripping up the stairs to the altar, forgetting the closing hymn, having Katie Gates remind me what comes next, and dancing with Stella.

I want to thank Stan, mostly for being a good sport. I said last year that he is what a pastor should look, and act, like. Nothing has made me want to change that opinion.

Finally, I would be remiss if I didn't add that none of this could have worked without Sandy Dudek's help, support, and yeoman's effort in the office. I could preach, visit, and attend meetings. I did not have time to administrate, in almost any capacity. She did all of that—almost half of what a minister is expected to accomplish. I'd say you should name something after her...but you already have!

June 9th won't be goodbye. We'll see each other soon. But, from the deepest part of my heart, I want to thank you for a wonderful year.
